AIRBRUSH: MAKE-UP WITH THE AIRBRUSH

Launched in the United States in the 1990s, Airbush make-up technique soon conquered cinema, fashion, advertising, special effects and even television. It provides an even blend of colors, infinite or almost infinite shades, use on all mediums (skin, synthetic materials, hair), and reinforced hygienic conditions: all advantages ensuring its undeniable success!

This training course is aimed at chief make-up artists, professional or artistic make-up artists (currently 17% of professional American make-up artists use the Airbrush technique).

Objective

- To acquire the techniques used to create make-up using an Airbrush
- To master the equipment, its implementation, its areas of application; the types of possible make-up and their lifespan.
- To discover and implement the new textures and materials in relation to the medium: face, body, hair, prosthetics.

Duration

5 7-hour days (9.00-0.30/1.30-5.00), that is to say 35 hours in total.

Program

Day I

- (Morning) Initiation, presentation of the equipment. The make-up Airbrush: demonstration, assembling, disassembling, cleaning. Products used.
- (Afternoon) Airbrush technique (pressure and rate). Individual practice on inert medium (mask).

Day 2

- (Morning) Demonstration of the techniques and choice of the products in accordance with the make-up artist's objective. The technique of masks and stencils.
- (Afternoon) Practice on live model: natural face make-up, sophisticated face make-up.

Day 3

- · (Morning) make-up of hair and scalp.
- (Afternoon) Body make-up, tanning and bikini lines, use of masks and stencils. Artistic creation: use of patterned stencils.

Day 4

 (All day) Practice of Airbrush make-up on thematic creations: period make-up, fashion make-up.
 Personal creation.

Day 5

- (Morning) Make-up special effects, bruises...
- (Afternoon) Application of prosthetics in gelatin or Dermplast Airbrush.



Products used

The participants must provide their own brushes, sponges, puff and make-up products. The specific airbrush products and equipment are provided. The compressor and airbrush are made available.
